Important information for members – please read!

Subscription rates are as follows:

Members living in the UK and Ireland:	£25
Members living elsewhere:	£30
Full-time postgraduate students (UK and Ireland):	£12.50

(Members of the **British-Italian Society** please note that the BIS has been obliged under HMRC rules to withdraw the mutual concessionary membership rate.)

The above rates include two issues of the Society's Journal *Italian Studies* per year.

Please complete the membership form overleaf and return it to me with your payment. Sterling cheques should be made payable to the *Society for Italian Studies*. **Please note that Direct Debit operations are temporarily suspended.** If you wish to pay through your bank or building society on an annual basis, this will again be possible once the necessary arrangements have been made. There has been a considerable delay in putting these arrangements in place: since the Society moved its funds to a new account with the CAF (Charities Aid Foundation) Bank, the Bank has been installing a new computer system and has been unable to set up new Direct Debit and on-line payment facilities. Details will be published on the SIS website <www.sis.ac.uk> as they become available. **In the meantime members should cancel any existing Direct Debit or Standing Order arrangement that directs payment to the Clydesdale Bank in Glasgow, as this account has now been closed, and, if possible, pay by cheque.** I apologize for this inconvenience and the inordinate delay in establishing alternative arrangements, but the arrangements now being concluded with the CAF Bank should enable the Society to provide a better service to members.

Members living outside the UK may pay by sterling cheque, bank draft, or credit card (Visa / Mastercard), using the form overleaf. Members are asked to pay in sterling wherever possible. Alternatively, payment may be made in US dollars (in which case the subscription rate is \$55), but **if you pay in dollars, please make cheques payable to W. S. Maney and Son Ltd**, to avoid excessive bank handling charges. All other cheques or drafts should be made out to the *Society for Italian Studies*.

If you have not received the recent issues of *Italian Studies*, this may be because I do not have a record of receiving a subscription from you for 2009. In a few cases the reason may be because payments were received without any indication of their source. If you think you may come into this category, or have any query concerning your subscription, please contact me. And, finally, **please notify me of any change of address to which issues of *Italian Studies* should be sent.**
